We successfully held our second graduation ceremony with 60 graduands, an impressive increase from the 17 who graduated last year. The ceremony also served as closing day for all learners.

Starting next year, only the graduating learners will attend the graduation ceremony with their families and guests. The rest of the school will hold class parties, also known as Sharing Day, on the final day of school after completing their exams.







Formation of the PTA Board

We established a PTA Board with representatives from every level—from kindergarten through grade 8—to strengthen collaboration between parents and school management.


Kindergarten Trial Class

This year, we launched our Kindergarten Trial Class, running every Friday from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM. The class is a replica of the actual Kindergarten class for children aged 2.5 to 3 years preparing to join Kindergarten.

Learners are provided with 10 o'clock tea and lunch at no cost. During the class, they develop skills in socialization, creative pattern-making, and psychomotor development, ensuring a smooth transition to full-time schooling.









STEM Pathways and Psychometric Testing for Grade 7 and 8

Our Grade 7 and 8 learners underwent psychometric tests to explore their strengths across the CBC Pathways:

STEM: Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics.

Social Sciences: Humanities, languages, and social studies.

Sports: Physical education and sports development.

To enhance their understanding of the pathways, learners and their parents visited the CBC Gravity Center, where they explored how these areas align with their interests and future career paths.

Hands-On Learning Projects (Based on CBC Curriculum)

Aligned with the Competency-Based Curriculum (CBC), learners across different grades completed exciting projects:

- Grade 4: Created still-life drawings, container gardens, and air pollution detectors.
- Grade 5: Decorated objects with mosaics, performed folk dances, managed nursery beds, and handled solid waste.
- Grade 7: Sang folk songs, demonstrated athletic skills, explored nutrition conservation, and studied the urinary system.
- Grade 8: Performed choral verses, demonstrated sports techniques, studied soil conservation, and investigated cell processes.




















STEM Enthusiasts Build a Website


CRA FACILITIES

Pre-School: Under the Sea(Village Market) - A Marine Life Experience


